COMMUNITY-ORIENTED OPEN SPACE AND CIVIC CENTER

Marmalade Plaza is the final piece set to complete the larger Marmalade Block development, which is comprised of The Harvest Apartments, The Grove Townhomes, and the Marmalade branch of the Salt Lake Public Library.

This open space's design includes a unique water feature lined with concrete seat walls, a main plaza surfaced in concrete that is etched with a vegetative pattern to reference the neighborhood's namesake, a tree-lined corridor with a lawn area that stems from 300 West, public art, and more.

It will be a place for people to congregate with friends and family, or to meet new neighbors and build connections.


